<input type="checkbox"/> Term 1 Swimming Lessons – P-2	In Term 1, there are 4 swimming lessons for Prep – Year 2. Children travel by bus to and from the pool. Cost is \$5 per lesson per child.
<input type="checkbox"/> T1 Swimming Carnivals and Swim Carnival Preparation– Years 3-6	Year 3-6 Students travel by bus to Aitkenvale SS for the Interhouse and Interschool Swimming Carnivals (selected students from Interhouse Carnival). Costs to be advised. There is also one practice lesson at a suitable pool. Cost is \$5 per lesson per child.
<input type="checkbox"/> RI Culminating Activity - Children's Easter Service	This is held at St Johns Anglican Church which is across the road from the school. The children walk to this event. This is planned by the school chaplain in conjunction with the religious instruction teachers. Cost is free.
<input type="checkbox"/> Red Track Athletics (selected students from Sports Carnival)	This is the Regional Sports Day held for school's similar in size to Townsville South at Red Track. Transport is by bus and is only for children who are selected. I understand and agree that if my child is born in 2010 they must either be transported back to school after their race or be transported by a staff member back to school after their race. Cost is \$10 per child.
<input type="checkbox"/> Arts Council	Queensland Arts Council Performances are designed for children from Prep – Year 6 and are held twice during the year. Cost is \$8 per child.
<input type="checkbox"/> P-6 Term 4 Swim and Survive Program	In Term 4 there will be up to 4 Swimming Lessons focussed on survival skills for all students in the school. Transport to the pool or Riverway Pool is by bus. \$5 per child/lesson.
<input type="checkbox"/> Year 4-6 Camp	Cost is approximately \$250 (the student council will be attempting to reduce the cost through fundraising). 92% attendance is required to be allowed to attend. Travel is to and from by bus.
<input type="checkbox"/> RI Culminating Activity - Children's Christmas Service	This is held at St Johns Anglican Church which is across the road from the school. The children walk to this event. This is planned by the school chaplain in conjunction with the religious instruction teachers. Cost is free.
<input type="checkbox"/> Movie Day	The children travel by bus to the movie cinemas to see a PG or G movie. Cost is \$12 per child which includes bus and movie ticket.
<input type="checkbox"/> Year 6 Big Day Out	To celebrate children's 7 years of schooling the year 6 children have a half day – Big Day Out at for an activity and lunch. I understand that transport is by staff or parent car transport. Costs to be advised.
<input type="checkbox"/> 2 Excursions – TBA	Permission is given to attend excursions within the Townsville area (a maximum of two with fees at no more than \$20 per child/trip). Some possible trips - Zoo, Museum, Art Gallery, Aquarium, Science Show that require either walking or bus.
<input type="checkbox"/> Religion Education Lessons	By ticking this box you confirm that you wish your child to participate in weekly Religious Education Lessons in 2016. Children who don't have permission will provided other instruction eg. wider reading, catch-up of class work, revision work, project work, basic fact practice etc. Cost is free.
<input type="checkbox"/> First and Last name and Photos to appear in Newspaper	By ticking this box you are agreeing to the publication of your child's full name in the newspaper. The Townsville Bulletin (and other newspapers) will not allow permission for your child's picture to be published without the permission for first and last name to be printed.
<input type="checkbox"/> Photos for Newsletter and School Website	By ticking this box you confirm your understanding and agreement that <i>'It is the school's usual practice to take photographs of students or record images of students and occasionally to publish personal information when reporting student activities through the school's newsletter, website, or, local media for the purposes of celebrating the student's achievements and promoting the school and state education.'</i> For the school newsletter and website, last names are not used.
<input type="checkbox"/> Gold Reward Day - Video T3	Children who earn 75 gotchas in Term 3 are invited to attend a reward session at school. P-2 children watch a G video, whilst year 3-6 children watch a PG or G video. Cost is free.
<input type="checkbox"/> Interschool Sports	Interschool Sport is for Year 4-6 children. Transport is by either parent private transport, parent volunteer drivers and staff transport. All driver's licenses and vehicle registrations are checked for currency and all children must wear a seat-belt. Cost is free.
<input type="checkbox"/> Radio Station Visits	From time to time the school has visits from local radio stations whereby children participate for fun events (eg. Chappy week). Children are able to speak on the radio and last names are not used. Cost is free.

Privacy Notice

The Department of Education and Training (DET) is collecting the personal information requested in this form in order to:
